- Mrs Clarke welcomed new pupils to RRS committee and provided everyone with a new RRS jotter.
- Action: The new children will get their RRS badge at the next meeting.
- Mrs Bruce and Mrs Clarke spoke to the children about the new Shanarri display downstairs.
- Action: Mrs Bruce to update display appropriately to include Shanarri of the Month. The children have
 to ask their class what Shanarri means to them and check that the Shanarri of the Month is being
 displayed in class alongside the Power of the Month.
